About Us

Goods and Services Tax Network (GSTN) has built Indirect Taxation platform for GST to help taxpayers in India to prepare, file returns, make payments of indirect tax liabilities and do other compliances. It provides IT infrastructure and services to the Central and State Governments, taxpayers and other stakeholders for implementation of the Goods and Services Tax (GST) in India.

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Be Vigilant: Never click on dubious links or share your OTP, passwords, or financial details in response to calls, emails, or messages. GSTN never asks for OTP or confidential information.

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What is e-Invoicing?



Definition

- i. 'e-Invoicing' refers to the reporting of specified GST documents to a Government-notified portal, known as the Invoice Registration Portal (IRP), for the purpose of obtaining an Invoice Reference Number (IRN). It does not mean that invoices are generated by any Government portal.
- ii. Under the e-Invoicing system, taxpayers continue to generate their GST invoices using their own Accounting, Billing, or ERP systems as per their business requirements.
- iii. These invoices are then reported to any of the six authorised Invoice Registration Portals (IRPs) in a standard, notified format (Schema - Form GST INV-01). Generation of the Invoice Reference Number (IRN) on any of these IRPs is completely free of charge.

e-Invoicing Applicability

Current Threshold (Effective 1st August 2023):

Annual Aggregate Turnover > Rs 5 Crore (in any of the preceding FY)

Key Compliance Rules:

- PAN-Based Calculation: Turnover calculated across ALL GSTINs under a single PAN
- All GSTINs Must Comply: If PAN crosses threshold, ALL GSTINs must generate e-invoices
- Timing: Applies from beginning of next financial year after crossing threshold

Example:

If a business has 3 GSTINs (Maharashtra, Gujarat, Karnataka) under one PAN with turnovers of Rs 2 crore, Rs 2 crore, and Rs 1.5 crore respectively, the total AATO is Rs 5.5 crore.

All three GSTINs must generate e-invoices from the next financial year.

Phased Implementation Timeline

Phase	Turnover Threshold	Effective Date	Legal Notification
Phase I	Rs 500 crore+	1 st October 2020	Notification 13/2020, 61/2020 & 70/2020 - Central Tax
Phase II	Rs 100 crore+	1 st January 2021	Notification 88/2020 - Central Tax
Phase III	Rs 50 crore+	1 st April 2021	Notification 5/2021 - Central Tax
Phase IV	Rs 20 crore+	1 st April 2022	Notification 1/2022 - Central Tax
Phase V	Rs 10 crore+	1 st October 2022	Notification 17/2022 – Central Tax
Phase VI	Rs 5 crore+	1st August 2023	Notification 10/2023 - Central Tax

Current Status: As of August 1, 2023, e-invoicing is mandatory for all businesses with annual aggregate turnover exceeding Rs. 5 crore.



e-Invoice Exempted Sectors

Some of the sectors exempted from e-invoicing requirements are:

- SEZ Units
 Notification 61/2020 Central Tax
- Insurance Companies
 Notification 13/2020 Central Tax
- Banking & Financial Institutions (including NBFCs)
 Notification 13/2020 Central Tax
- Goods Transport Agencies (GTA)
 Notification 13/2020 Central Tax
- Passenger Transport Services
 Notification 13/2020 Central Tax
- 6 Cinematograph Films in Multiplex Screens
 Notification 13/2020 Central Tax
- Government Departments & Local Authorities
 Notification 23/2021 Central Tax

Remember:

All seven exempted sectors are excluded from e-invoicing requirements regardless of their annual aggregate turnover. Even if these businesses exceed Rs 5 crore turnover, they do not need to generate e-invoices.

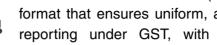






What is e-Invoice Schema

FORM GST INV-01



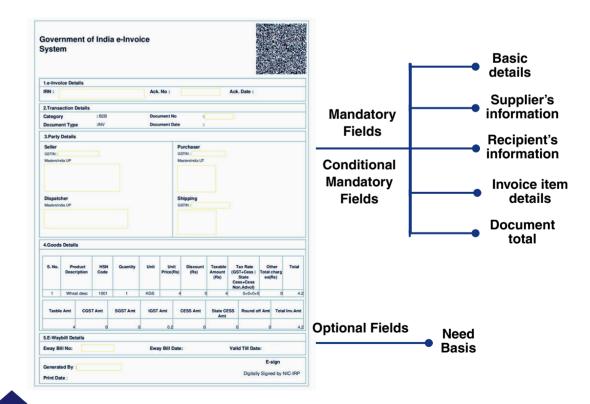
The B2B e-Invoice schema (FORM INV-01) is a standardized JSON format that ensures uniform, accurate, and automated B2B e-invoice reporting under GST, with defined mandatory, conditional, and optional fields and built-in compliance validations.



Its flexible, sector-agnostic design suits the diverse needs of the Indian economy, while cryptographic IRN generation, IRP signatures, and a signed QR code ensure trust and auditability.



Aligned with GSTR-1 and e-way bill structures, it enables seamless automation across returns, reconciliation, and analytics, forming a key pillar of India's GST system.





Understanding IRN (Invoice Reference Number)

What is IRN?

- i. The Invoice Reference Number (IRN) is a unique 64-character alphanumeric hash generated by the Invoice Registration Portal (IRP) for every valid e-invoice reported.
- ii. It serves as a unique identifier for the e-Invoice throughout its lifecycle.

IRN Generation Parameters:

Seller GSTIN

15-character GST identification number of the supplier

Financial Year

YYYY-YY format (e.g., 2023-24)

Key Features of IRN:

- Unique for each e-Invoice
- Valid for entire e-Invoice lifecycle

2 Invoice Number

Unique invoice number as per taxpayer's system

4 Document Type

INV (Invoice), DN (Debit Note), or CN (Credit Note)

- Cannot be changed once generated
- Can be used for E-Way Bill generation

IRN Cancellation Rules

IRN Can Be Cancelled Within 24 Hours of Generation

Cancellation Rules:

√ Within 24 Hours of IRN Generation:

- Can cancel IRN on the IRP portal
- Can reissue new e-Invoice with different IRN
- Cancellation is permanent and irreversible

X After 24 Hours of IRN Generation:

- Cannot cancel IRN
- Cancelled IRN cannot be reactivated

e-Invoice **Invoice Registration Portals (IRPs)**

All IRPs are governed by GSTN

What is IRP?

- i. An Invoice Registration Portal (IRP) is an official platform, authorized by the government, where businesses (meeting a specified annual turnover threshold) must report their B2B / export invoices, and credit/debit note details electronically.
- ii. The primary function of the IRP is to authenticate these invoices and issue a unique Invoice Reference Number (IRN) and a digitally signed QR code for each document.

All six IRPs perform the following critical functions:

- Issue Unique Invoice Reference Number (IRN) Generate 64-character hash-based IRN using seller GSTIN, invoice number, financial year, and document type.
- **Generate Digitally Signed QR Code** Create digitally signed QR code with encrypted invoice details for verification by tax authorities and buyers.
- Validate Invoice Details and Check for Duplications Verify mandatory fields, validate data formats, and ensure no duplicate IRN exists.
- Forward Data to GST and E-Way Bill Portals Transmit authenticated invoice data to GST system for GSTR-1 auto-population and e-way bill portal.

Important:

All IRPs (government and private) perform identical functions following GSTN standards. Taxpayers can choose any IRP based on convenience or ERP integration capabilities.

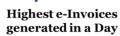


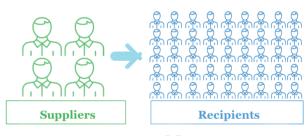

Glossary on e-Invoicing

Signed e-Invoice

This refers to an e-Invoice that has been digitally signed by the Invoice Registration Portal (IRP) after validation. The signed e-Invoice is provided with a unique IRN and QR code.

Credit Note in GST

A credit note is issued by a supplier for reduction in the taxable value or taxes of a previously issued invoices. Also, Credit Note can be issued for sales return or where goods or services are found to be deficit.

Debit Note in GST

A debit note is issued by a supplier for increase in the taxable value or taxes of a previously issued invoices.

OTP

One-Time Password (OTP) is a password that is valid for only one login session or transaction. During the registration process on an IRP, an OTP is sent to the registered mobile number for verification...

IRN (Invoice Reference Number)

The unique identifier for every e-Invoice reported on an IRP. It is based on the computation of a hash of the supplier's GSTIN, the financial year, the document type, and the document number.

Enablement

The process of registering and enabling a taxpayer for e-Invoicing on the GST portal, allowing them to report e-Invoices on any of the six IRPs. Taxpayers are automatically enabled for e-Invoicing based on AATO but if not enabled they need to be self-enabled on the portal. Link https://einvoice.gst.gov.in

GSTR-1

A monthly return that taxpayers need to file, which contains details of outward supplies, including elevice data.

GSTN e-Services App

The mobile application designed to enhance the verification process for B2B e-Invoices. It allows users to easily verify e-Invoices by scanning the QR code, providing key details of the e-Invoice and live status of the IRN, whether active or cancelled. The app also enables users to search for registered business details using GSTIN or PAN and view their return filing history, and the return filing status of the business.

JSON Format

JSON (JavaScript Object Notation) is a standard data interchange format. For e-Invoicing, the e-Invoice data must be uploaded in a predefined schema INV01 in JSON format.

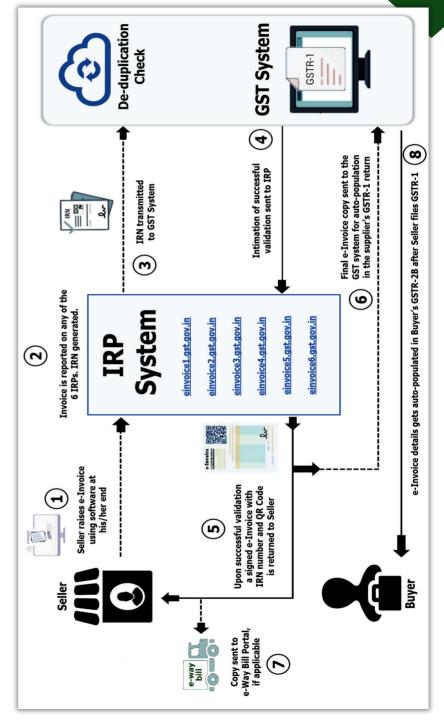
B2B e-Invoices

These are e-Invoices issued in a business-to-business transaction. e-Invoicing requirements in India currently apply to B2B for certain taxpayers and exports, based on their annual aggregate turnover.

Auto-population

TThis refers to the automatic filling of data in a field. In the context of e-Invoicing, once an e-Invoice has been validated and has received an IRN, the data from the e-Invoice is auto-populated into the supplier's GSTR-1 form in the GST system.

Glossary on e-Invoicing

e-Invoicina

'e-Invoicing' means reporting details of specified GST documents to a Government notified portal i.e. Invoice Registration Portal (IRP) and obtaining an Invoice Reference Number (IRN). It doesn't mean the generation of invoices by a Government portal.

IRP (Invoice Registration Portal)

It is a Government approved platform where notified persons upload or report e-Invoices. Currently, six portals are authorised to generate IRN on reporting of e-Invoices as per Rule 48(4) of the CGST Rules. Reporting e-Invoices and generating Invoice Reference Numbers (IRNs) on any of these portals is free of charge.

AATO (Annual Aggregate Turnover)

AATO (Annual Aggregate Turnover) for e-Invoicing is calculated based on the PAN of a taxpayer and the information provided in their GSTR-3B returns. It represents the total turnover of the taxpayer during a financial year and is used to determine the applicability of e-Invoice reporting requirements.

GSTIN (Goods and Services Tax Identification Number)

A unique identification number assigned to each registered taxpayer under the GST system.

e-Invoice QR Code

A type of two-dimensional barcode that can be read by a digital device and provides information about the e-Invoice. The QR code generated for e-Invoicing includes parameters such as the supplier's GSTIN, the recipient's GSTIN, e-Invoice number, date of generation of the e-Invoice, e-Invoice value, IRN, etc.

e-Invoice FO (Front Office) Portal

The official web portal provided by GSTN where taxpayers can access various e-Invoice related functionalities, including enablement status, e-Invoice generation, and searching for IRNs. It also provides links to all six IRPs, e-Invoice schema, master codes, enablement status, search IRN functionality, etc. (Link https://einvoice.gst.gov.in)

API for e-Invoice Reporting

IRPs offer API-based functionality for reporting e-Invoices. API (Application Programming Interface) is a set of protocols for building and integrating software applications.

ERP System

Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system is a type of software used by companies to manage their day to day business activities. Taxpayers can continue to generate e-Invoices from their current ERP system, but details of all such B2B e-Invoices need to be uploaded or reported on an Invoice Registration Portal (IRP) in a notified format.

e-Invoice schema

(INV-1 - Version 1.1) The e-Invoice schema is a predefined and standardised framework that defines the structure of the e-Invoice, including mandatory and optional fields, their format and rules for the generation of an e-Invoice.

Master codes

Master codes refer to a set of pre-defined codes used in the e-Invoicing system, such as HSN codes, country codes, currency codes, state codes, and others.

- The e-Invoice master information portal is the official platform developed and managed by GSTN (Goods and Services Tax Network) to facilitate and support multiple IRP ecosystem under e-Invoicing in GST.

- i. Enablement Status Check
- ii. IRP Access Links
- iii. e-Invoice Schema & Master Codes
- iv. Search & Verification Tools

- vi. Support & Updates

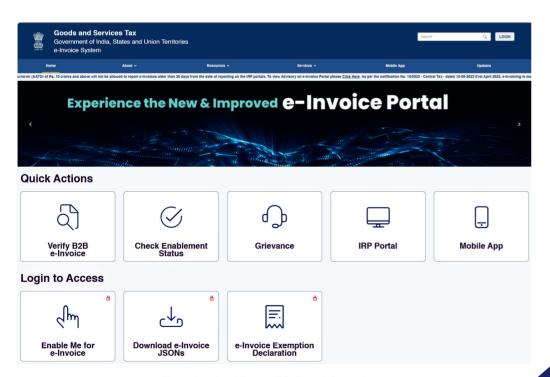


Fig. e-Invoice Master FO Portal Snapshot
